Congratulations on your acceptance into the Clarinet Program! We have an exciting week of lessons, master classes, ensemble rehearsals, special presentations, and performances planned for you. Following is some important information about the program.

Audition

The audition is used to place and seat you in the clarinet choir. Please pick a solo or other material that demonstrates your playing abilities at their absolute best. Also, prepare major scales through three sharps and three flats. Sight reading will be included. Auditions take place on registration day.

Required Equipment

Bring a folding stand, clarinet, and related equipment such as reeds.

Required Solo Piece

Bring a solo piece of your choosing. This may be the same piece that you prepared for your audition. A major portion of the program is devoted to individual coaching and preparation/performance of a solo work for clarinet and piano. You should have this piece prepared when you arrive on campus.
